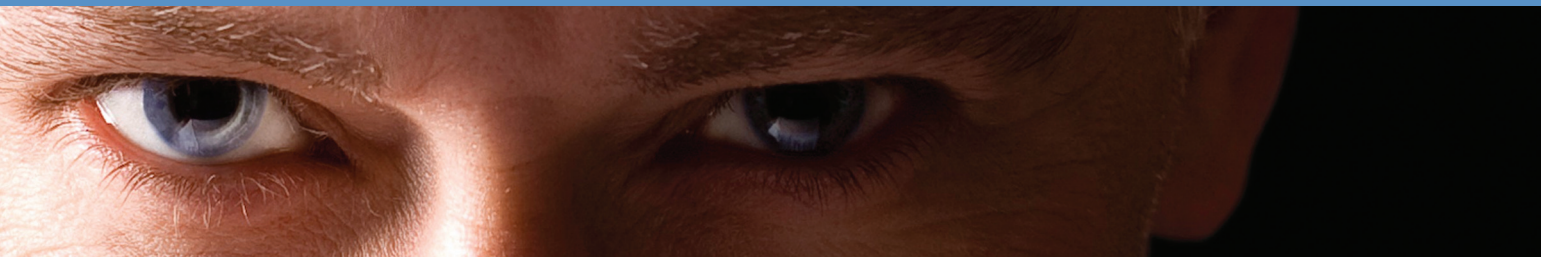

Assessing Psychopathy and Risk for Violence

Presented by Professor James Ogloff and Dr Michael Davis

This three day workshop will provide participants with accredited training in the administration and scoring of the Hare Psychopathy Checklist, Revised. Particular attention will be paid to the assessment of psychopathy and risk for violence.

Participants will be provided with a comprehensive understanding of the construct of psychopathy. Participants will be trained in the administration of the Hare Psychopathy Checklist - Revised and the Hare Psychopathy Checklist: Screening Version. Participants will be trained to administer additional risk assessment tools that incorporate the Hare scales (i.e., the HCR-20). Considerable time will be spent having participants assess psychopathy and risk for violence in demonstration cases. Additional violence risk tools will be identified. Finally, depending on participant interest and need, some attention will be paid to the assessment of risk in specific populations.

Professor James Ogloff



Trained as a lawyer and psychologist, Professor James R. P. Ogloff has worked with mentally ill people in the criminal justice system for more than 25 years.

He is Foundation Professor of Clinical Forensic Psychology and Director of the Centre for Forensic Behavioural

Science at Monash University. He is also Director of Psychological Services for the Victorian Institute of Forensic Mental Health.

He has worked in the area of psychopathy since 1984. He has held many leadership roles in psychology in Australia and overseas.

Professor Ogloff is a respected researcher and clinician whose work has been recognised by a number of awards including, being most recently the recipient of the 2012 Donald Andrews Career Contribution Award for Criminal Justice Psychology from the Canadian Psychological Association.

Dr Michael R. Davis



Dr Michael Davis is a Clinical Forensic Psychologist in private practice and a Research Fellow with the Centre for Forensic Behavioural Science at Monash University.

He has presented nationally and internationally on the topics of violence risk assessment, psychopathy,

offender profiling, equivocal death, paraphilias, behavioural crime linkage, and other aspects of sexual and violent crime. He has conducted hundreds of risk assessments for the courts and in consultation for area mental health services, government departments, and private lawyers.

Dr Davis is the Victorian Branch Chair of the APS College of Forensic Psychologists and the Victorian Branch Secretary of ANZAPPL. He is a member of the Australian Forensic Reference Group (Victoria Police) and regularly provides assistance to the Behavioural Analysis Unit.

He has provided behavioural investigative advice to police in several different countries and is the only psychologist in Australia to be elected to membership of the International Criminal Investigative Analysis Fellowship (ICIAF). Dr Davis serves on the editorial board of the *Journal of Investigative Psychology and Offender Profiling*.
